



COMPUTER GRAPHICS

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- Entrants may submit up to three (3) entries.
- Work must have been created during the past calendar year.
- Entrants are required to complete and submit a separate entry form for each entry.
- Submission of an entry form, by any means, indicates the Entrants acceptance of rules and certifies the entry as their own work. Entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor (or parent guardian if under 18 years of age).
- Graphics exhibits made from 'stitched' artwork will not be accepted without significant modification. The exhibitor must state on the entry form if the exhibit is from a website/designer and what portion is made from said website/designer.
- Depending on the number of entries, not all entries may be shown in the exhibit.
- Large exhibit items will be displayed only if there is sufficient exhibit space.
- Organizers of Artilepsy have final determination in the display of entries.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

- Entry forms and photographs must be mailed or delivered to *Epilepsy Association of Utah, 8539 S Redwood Rd Suite B, West Jordan UT 84088* by end of business on **Thursday, June 30, 2016**
- The completed entry form **MUST** accompany the entries, or they will not be judged.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Competition will be offered in the classes listed below:

- Adult: 18+
- Teen: 12-17
- Youth: Under 12

JUDGING

The following categories are a general guide to entrants in preparing their entries and will be followed by the judges in making awards.

- Workmanship
- Design – beauty and originality
- Suitability of articles to purpose
- Harmony of colors and material
- Cleanliness – pressing and blocking (if appropriate)
- Bonus – original design, uniqueness, etc.

Entries that do not meet the exhibit or community standards or rules will not be displayed. The organizers of Artilepsy have final determination about the appropriateness of the entries for exhibit.

All decisions of the judges will be final.
