



PHOTOGRAPHY

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- Entrants may be amateur or professional photographers.
- Entrants may submit up to three (3) entries.
- Photographs must have been taken during the past calendar year.
- The original image must have been taken by the exhibitor using film, slide or digital camera.
- Entrants are required to complete and submit a separate entry form for each entry.
- Submission of an entry form, by any means, indicates the Entrants acceptance of rules and certifies photographs as their own work. Entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor (or parent guardian if under 18 years of age).
- No information is allowed on the front of the photograph or mounting board.
- Depending on the number of entries, not all entries may be shown in the exhibit.
- Large exhibit items will be displayed only if there is sufficient exhibit space.
- Organizers of Artilepsy have final determination in the display of entries.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

- Entry forms and photographs must be mailed or delivered to *Epilepsy Association of Utah, 8539 S Redwood Rd Suite B, West Jordan UT 84088* by end of business on **Thursday, June 30, 2016**
- The completed entry form **MUST** accompany the entries, or they will not be judged.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Competition will be offered in the classes listed below:

- Adult: 18+
- Teen: 12-17
- Youth: Under 12

PRINT SIZE AND REQUIREMENTS

- Image size up to 16" x 20"
- No mat over the front of the print.
- No information allowed on the front of the print.
- Prints may be coated with a protective photographic lacquer or spray gloss.
- All images must be original and may not include elements produced by anyone else.
- Entrants in the Youth class (under 12) may have assistance
- Processing and printing may be done commercially or by the exhibitor.
- Final image must be on photographic or electronic print material.

MOUNTING BOARDS

- Mount board size up to 16" x 20"
- Entries with incorrect size mounting board will be disqualified.
- Mounting board must be from 1/8" to 1/4" thick.
- Mounting board must be standard mat or foam core board. No wood or masonite will be accepted.
- No framed, glass covered, or shrink-wrapped entries.
- No hanging devices or other protrusions allowed on the back or front of entry.
- No title, name or other information may be printed or attached to the front of the mounting board.

PRINT MOUNTING

- Prints must be affixed to the mounting board. Do not use double sided tape.
- Prints that fall off due to poor mounting will not be repaired, may not be judged and will be removed from the exhibit.

JUDGING

Prizes will be awarded based on the judges' evaluation of the following (not necessarily in this order):

- Photograph's overall presentation
- Photographic
 - Technique
 - Impact
 - Originality
 - Composition
 - Other pertinent factors

Prints that do not meet the exhibit or community standards or rules will not be displayed. The organizers of Artilepsy have final determination about the appropriateness of the entries for exhibit.

All decisions of the judges will be final.

MISCELLANEOUS

Artilepsy personnel and volunteers will use care to secure the safety of entries. However, no responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen photographs is assumed by Artilepsy, the Epilepsy Association of Utah, or the Salt Lake City Library. Artilepsy does not insure the photographs. Artilepsy is not responsible for misuse of copyright by an exhibitor.
